The results of a certified criminal record check can have consequences that can affect you personally. Some of the consequences may include loss of employment opportunities and rejection of your volunteer application.

Use of Personal Information

- Your personal information will be used by governments in Canada, private companies, and other bodies that you authorize for security and reliability screening.
- 💢 If you are a person of interest or involved in a criminal investigation, your personal information may be shared with the investigating agency.
- Personal information banks (PIB) RCMP PPU 065, RCMP PPU 030, and RCMP PPU 005 provide detailed information about how the RCMP collects, uses, discloses, retains, and/or disposes of information provided for certified criminal record check applications. These PIBs also provide other information not related to civil applications.

- You are giving consent to CCRTIS to notify the relevant police agency of any new information that you may have provided on your certified criminal record check application (e.g. new name, new address).
- Your personal information is searched and disclosed in accordance with Canadian law, including the Privacy Act, Criminal Records Act, Youth Criminal Justice Act, and the Ministerial directive concerning the release of criminal record information by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. In some cases, personal information may be disclosed without your consent in accordance with subsection 8(2) of the Privacy Act. If you have been charged and subsequently convicted, you likely have a criminal record on file at CCRTIS' National Repository of Criminal Records and/or applicable local police databases. If you have been charged but not convicted, you may have non-conviction information on file at CCRTIS' National Repository of Criminal Records and/or applicable local police databases.

Record Suspension (pardoned) Information

CCRTIS must seek approval from the Minister of Public Safety for the release of record suspension (pardoned) information.

Fingerprint Destruction

With the exception of individuals employed or who are applying for employment with the RCMP, CCRTIS is not authorized to keep the fingerprints you provided for this application. CCRTIS destroys fingerprint submissions after the application is processed and they are not further used or added to RCMP systems.

Delivery of Your Results

- CCRTIS issues one product and only allows for one method of delivery per application submission.
- The processing of your application can take 3 to 120 business days, depending on whether manual intervention is required, if there is a match to a criminal record, and/or if CCRTIS has to clarify parts of the application with the submitting agency.
- Search results for federal government or police employment application types are always sent directly to the agency where you made your application. For other employment/volunteer application types, you can authorize the RCMP to send the results to a third party (e.g. agency, lawyer, friend). You must complete a third-party consent form; however, this means you will not receive a copy of your results from CCRTIS.
- CCRTIS may send your criminal record search result in an electronic format directly to the police agency that is processing your certified criminal record check application. The police agency uses the search result and creates its own criminal record check product to provide to you. CCRTIS is not responsible for the delivery of these products.

Unless otherwise directed, you may choose to receive your certified criminal record check by post via Canada Post. The use of Canada Post's delivery service may present certain risks including but not limited to:

- Some privacy risks exist when using postal services.

SHIPPING STANDARDS

#1. RCMP Processing Times

RCMP takes an average of 3 to 7 days to process your request (provided you have no criminal record in Canada AND your fingerprints are not too difficult to read). If you have a criminal record OR hard to read fingerprints, it could take over 120 days for the RCMP to process your request. You then need to add on the time it takes for the results to be delivered to you.

#2. Canada Post Ordinary Mail

The RCMP will ONLY mail the results via ordinary mail. The RCMP will NOT courier the results. The following are average times for RCMP to mail the results to your specified address.

(a) Results mailed from RCMP Ottawa to a Canadian Address: 3 to 5 business days

NOTE: Canada Post advises it could take upwards of 9 days if you live in a remote area.

(b) Results mailed from RCMP Ottawa to a U.S.A. or International Address

The estimated delivery standards for Letter-post (U.S.A. and International) are:

U.S.A. 4 to 6 business days

International 4 to 7 business days

NOTE: It could take longer if you are in a remote area. Canada Post does not guarantee these delivery standards. Postal delivery times within your country by your local delivery service is in addition to above.

CAUTION: please check post office in your country for delivery standards. Canada Post delivers to your country and post office in your country delivers to you.
